DAPP ZIMBABWE'S HEALTH PROGRAMS

- Total Control of the Epidemic (TCE) model implemented in collaboration with the Ministry of Health, mobilizes communities to take charge of their own health.
- Upskills community health workers to address the high TB-HIV co-infection rate through integrated screening and care.
- Targets and empowers at-risk, vulnerable populations.

► HIV/AIDS

DAPP's programs deliver HIV knowledge, treatment adherence support, prevention, and increase uptake of HIV Testing and Counselling.

During DAPP's Hope Bindura project:

- 126,129 people were mobilized for HTS in the past five years
- 1,460 TRIOs were formed to support ART adherence



► Tuberculosis

DAPP's TB program in Makoni provides access to chest x-rays and sputum transport to better identify asymptomatic TB and reduce time to diagnosis. Under the project, DAPP ensured:

- 150,000 people were screened for TB
- 4,440+ identified as presumptive for TB
- 50% of those diagnosed with TB were initiated on treatment within three days of giving their sputum sample

► HOPE- Integrated Care

By collaborating with local health facilities and conducting targeted outreach, DAPP reduces HIV transmission and promotes healthier living for over 32,000 people annually.
